


ATEN RS232 -> USB adapter

Windows 10/11 install


1. Click the looking glass next to the Windows Start button and type “*Device Manager*”. Open the Device Manager when found. You need to install the ATEN drivers if you find “*USB-Serial Controller D*” with an exclamation mark as shown below.




2. Right click the *USB-Serial Controller D* and choose “*Update driver*” from the menu




3. Choose *Search for drivers automatically*



4. Choose “*Search for updated drivers on Windows Update*” if Windows would fail to find the drivers.




5. Click “*Check for updates*”



6. and [click] “*View optional updates*”



7. Select ATEN driver and click “Download and install”



8. Verify that the ATEN adapter is showing as it should in the *Device Manager* after the installation:
