
Blinking forever

A. BLINKING SLOWLY

Symptom: The power lamp blinks fast at power up, then changes tempo after a few seconds and **blinks** in a slower tempo indefinitely. See section B. below if the power lamp does not change tempo but continues to blink fast indefinitely.

- 1. Remove the cover
- 2. Remove the mini USB memory stick (flash drive) and let a Windows computer scan and repair it.



3. Put the memory stick in the slot that you removed it from.

B. BLINKING FAST

Symptom: The power lamp blinks fast at power up and continues to blink fast indefinitely.

1. Remove the cover

2. Check that the cable between the motherboard and the sub-PCB to the left of the motherboard is properly connected at both ends.



- 3. You need to contact support@duplimate.com if the lamp blinks fast even though the cable is properly connected.
- 4. If you are mechanically minded you could ask support to send a new memory card. It is easy to replace the memory card, but it is not so easy to get at it. First you have to remove the upper sub-PCB, see illustration to the right. Take a photo of how the cables sit before dismantling! That is both the red and black to the right in the illustration and USB cables to the left.
- 5. Continue with the lower PCB. The memory card sits on the back side of the lower PCB.
- 6. Be careful so that you put cables back in their original position when you mount the sub PCBs!
